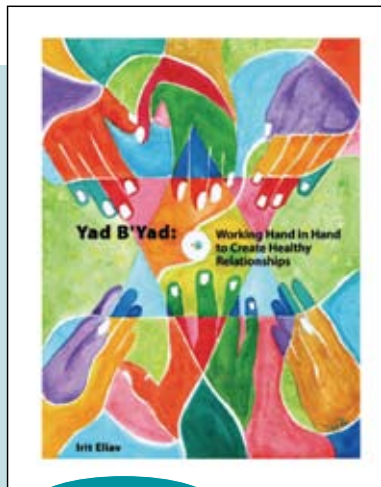

YAD B'YAD: Working Hand in Hand to Create Healthy Relationships By Irit Eliav

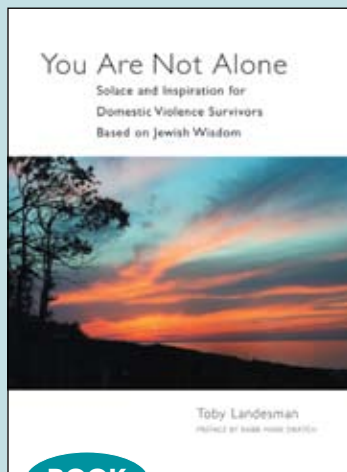
